PROCESS ANALYST

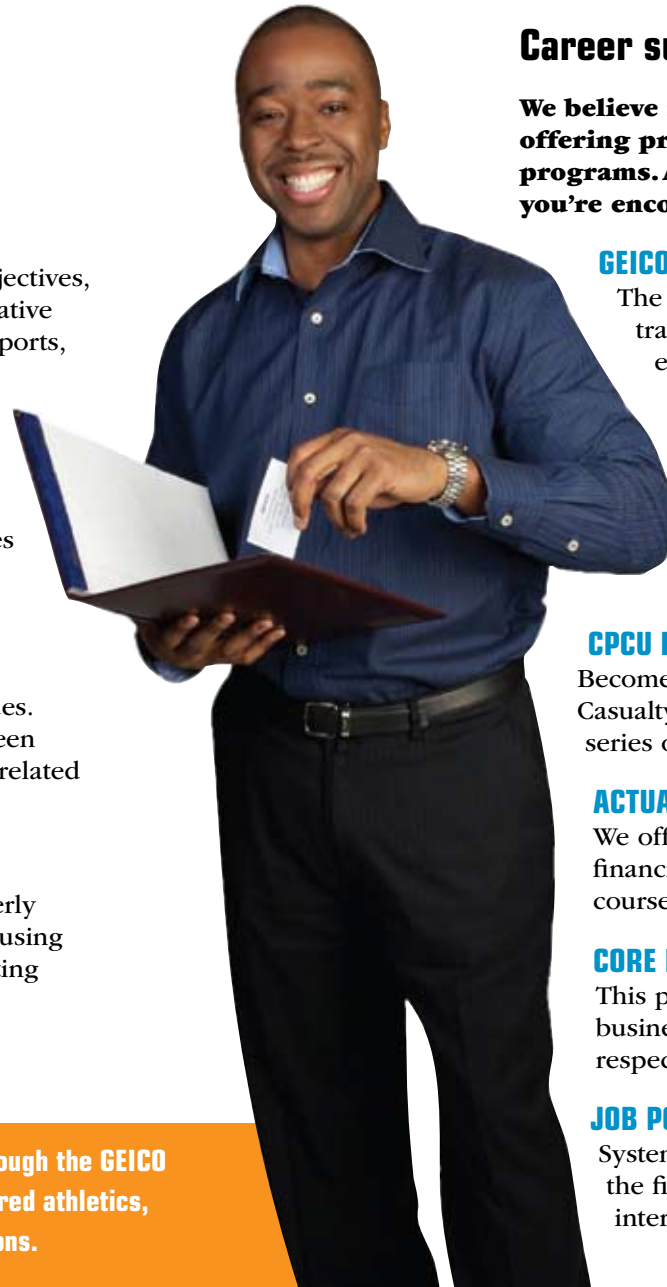
