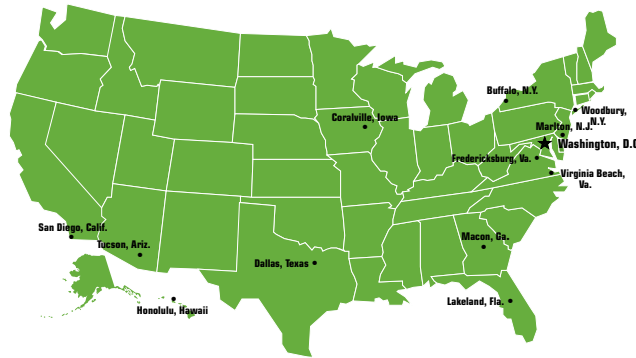

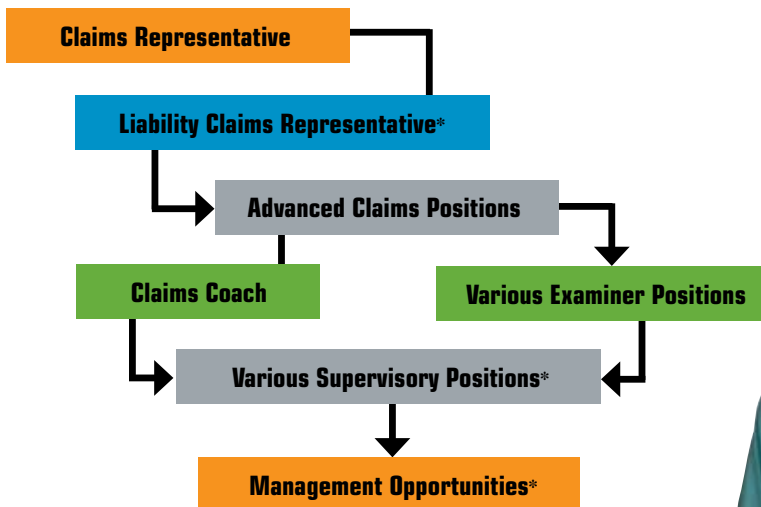

Do these words describe you? If so, consider a career in claims – it's one of the most important services that GEICO provides. New associates can start as a Claims Representative or a Liability Claims Representative*.

As a **Claims Representative**, you'll help settle claims where there are no injuries and everyone agrees to the accident details. A typical day includes handling phone inquiries from policyholders, claimants and repair shops, and ensuring fair claims handling. You will verify accident facts, determine policy coverage and review insurance contracts.

Liability Claims Representatives investigate claims that involve liability disputes, which can be quite complex! In this position, your job is to listen to all sides of the story, review supporting case files and arrive at an equitable decision. You'll work with policyholders, claimants, doctors' offices, medical insurers, repair shops and possibly law enforcement.

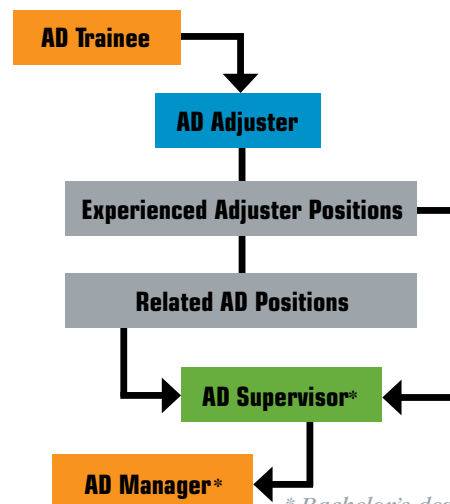
